Subject: Request for Access to Document (No. 03501)

Dear Mrs. Izuzquiza,

Reference is made to your e-mail dated 3 May 2019, in which you submitted a request for access to the following documents:

For the years 2017, 2018 and 2019:

- any and all documents that contain the number of staff in the Unit dealing with access to EU documents requests;
- any and all documents containing the budget for the Unit dealing with access to EU documents requests.

For the years 2016, 2017 and 2018:

- any and all documents containing data on the handling of access to EU documents requests by EASO (i.e. broken down data, per year, on the number of initial access to documents applications received, and the number of confirmatory applications received).

We would like to inform you, that the request (no. 03501) has been treated as one falling under the provisions of Regulation No 1049/2001 regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents, which also applies to EASO documents, and in accordance with Decision No 6 laying down practical arrangements regarding public access to the documents of EASO, as adopted by its Management Board on 20 September 2011.



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We wish to inform you on our attempt to contact you by email dated 10 May 2019 with a request for clarification. In line with the Article 6 (4) of Regulation (EC) 1049/2001: "...the Institution shall provide information and assistance to citizens on how and where applications for access to documents can be made." Our intention was to support you in process of identifying the exact scope of the first part of your request which would enable us to identify the documents, so that your expectations are met.

As a response was not yet received, it is our general presumption that the actual subject of your request are documents related to the budget and staff of the Communication and Stakeholder's Unit, which deals in EASO with access to documents and information.
