Thank you for your request dated 3 May 2019¹, in which you apply for access to certain Single Resolution Board ("**SRB**") documents.

Please note that your application is currently being treated in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents² ("**Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001**") and the SRB Decision of 9 February 2017 on public access to the Single Resolution Board documents³ ("**Public Access Decision**").

However, I will not be in a position to complete the handling of your application within the time limit of 15 working days, which expires on 28 May 2019. An extended time limit is required in consideration of the need to consult various units within the SRB in accordance with the applicable legal framework.
