Dear all,

Hereby a short outcome of the VC meeting which took place on 3 July:

- **Joint paper and its dissemination:**
 - JHA agencies will upload the final document on their websites (no obligation) and promote it via social media.
 - Reference was made to the communication package prepared last year for the joint statement on the Charter on FR, as a good example.
 - JHA agencies also support the sending of letters to Stakeholders; Eurojust will consult the CPs on a list of stakeholders and the draft letter (the letter will be based on the news item).
 - Tour the table: feedback on draft paper; written input to be provided in the next days; actions with internal measures are not to be included (but are reflected in the compilation)
 - JHA agencies will update the compilation on SharePoint by the Monday 6 July
 - EJ will strive to send out the joint paper by 7 July

- **VC Meeting, 9 July:**
 - Heads will intervene in both sessions. In session I we foresee a slot of max 6 minutes, in Session II a slot of maximum 2 minutes.
 - In the second session, Heads are invited to share views on a joint outlook on 1 or 2 topics/area; there will be no time for discussion/reactions/questions; we therefore agreed to take minutes and use the material for discussion and follow up at working level also in view of preparing the annual meeting in November.

- **News item, to be published on 15 July:**
 - Content: joint paper, 10th Anniversary of the network and 2-3 sentences on the VC meeting of the Heads of JHA agencies.
 - Process:
 - First draft by 10/7
 - Consultation/approval via CPs JHAAN by 14/7
 - Publication: 15/7
