Dear colleagues,

You will have noted that Public Access to Documents is one of the topics Eurojust identified for the JHA Network in 2020.

PAD was also a topic selected by Europol this year and we had an exchange in the first meeting of the network in February. We also created a list of contact points of the JHA Agencies. At the second network meeting, we agreed that there was no necessity in creating an expert group on PAD. At that time Eurojust mentioned the possibility of a one off training tailor-made for JHA Agencies. We explored the matter and consulted the Commission who has kindly offered its support and will provide a training to staff of the 9 JHA agencies dealing with PAD requests. The training will also allow for an exchange of challenges and best practice.

Please note that the training will take place on **28 January 2020** in Brussels at the Commission. A formal invitation with an agenda will be sent to the agencies beginning of January.
