Article 3 - Best practices

 enable the exchange of information and the <u>identification and pooling of best practices</u> in asylum matters between MS

Article 5 - Supporting relocation of beneficiaries of international protection within the Union

 promote, facilitate and coordinate exchanges of information and other activities related to relocation within the Union

Article 7 - Support for the external dimensions of the CEAS

coordinate exchanges of information and other <u>actions on resettlement taken by MS</u>

Article 9 - Gathering and analysing information


• analyse data on any sudden arrival of large numbers of third country nationals

Article 11 - Gathering and exchanging information

- factual, legal and case-law databases on implementation of relevant instruments of the asylum acquis
- no personal data shall be stored in such databases, unless obtained from documents that are publicly accessible




