"Environmental crimes are widely recognised as some of the most profitable forms of transnational crime. In a wider sense, it is likely to be the fourth largest criminal area in the world after drug trafficking, counterfeit crimes and human trafficking. One of the most serious forms of environmental crime is illegal shipment of waste. It is a problem both for intra-EU shipment of waste and for export outside the EU."

"The transition from linear to circular economy sets out to decouple our growth and wellbeing from consumption of natural resources and its environmental impact. The Circular Economy Action Plan therefore encompasses policies to encourage resource efficiency, sustainable product design and new business models, and to reduce waste and boost recycling. The pressures on natural resources are linked to the global acceleration in their use; the Circular Economy Action Plan therefore focuses on key value chains, such as textiles and ICT, that are responsible for most of these pressures."
