The conclusions of the meeting aim to assist the drafting of a JHAA Network paper/report with an overview of agencies' support to victims of human trafficking. The paper can be then disseminated to the Member States to make them aware of the roles and victims' related actions undertaken by the JHA agencies in the implementation of their 2018 Joint Statement against THB.

I would like to remind you that the joint paper/reporting constitutes a key action of the EU Strategy against THB 2021-2025.
