...defines the strategic interests of the EU in the maritime domain, and details how the EU defends those interests, by addressing all related threats and challenges;

...promotes stability, the rule of law and good maritime governance at the EU and global level

Contribution to the strategic priorities defined in the EU Strategic Agenda for 2019-2024:


Strengthening maritime security contributed to:
