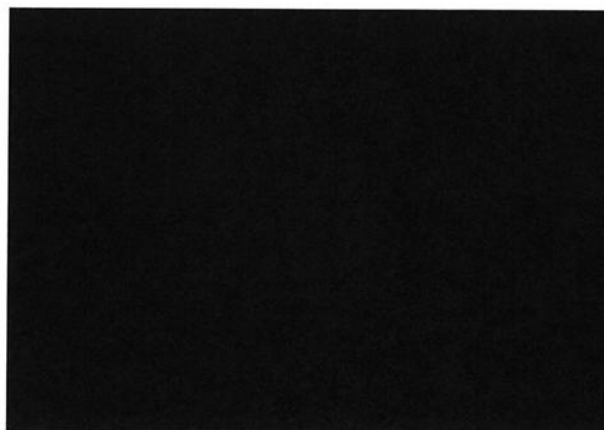

Introduction

On May the 18th 2016 Europol and Capgemini have agreed a Settlement Agreement (Annex I). As part of this Settlement Agreement all work in progress on deliverables produced by Capgemini and not accepted by Europol up to the signature date of the final Settlement Agreement will be handed over to Europol 'as is'.

The objective of this handover document is to describe the handover procedure. The handover procedure will be supervised by the named project managers of both parties and its closure shall be certified in writing.

The purpose of this document is the formal handover of all material described below from Capgemini to Europol. There is no physical handover as all material is physically already located on the network and machines that belong to Europol.

Handover Material

Capgemini will formally deliver to Europol all documentation and software artefacts in source control (subversion) needed to continue and complete the development of the EAS Solution:

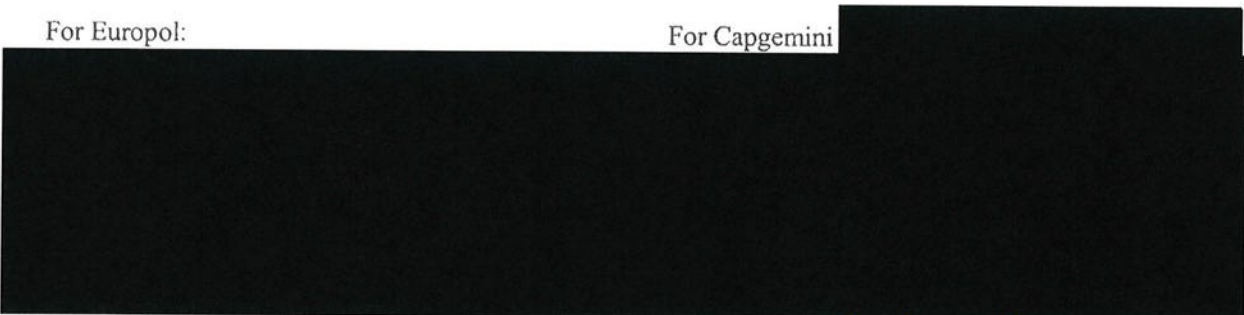
- (i) All source code, including versioning and history of changes. The source code has always been present under version control in the Europol subversion system.
- (ii) human and machine readable code
- (iii) Build and deployment scripts. All build and deployment scripts that have (partly) been developed by Capgemini and/or Palantir resources as part of the Europol EAS project are available on the Europol network.
- (iv) Data migration scripts. All data migration scripts are available to the Europol team on the network.
- (v) Design documentation. All design documentation is stored in the agreed directories on the Europol network.
- (vi) Test documentation. All test documentation is stored in the agreed directories on the Europol network.
- (vii) Full project documentation repository. All project documentation is stored in the agreed directories on the Europol network.
