the working condition as well. It generated a lot of dust. Some boxes were placed near the entrance. In case of an emergency the this could have been possible obstacles like a stumbling block.
I also wanted to avoid stocking all these things in our office till they are expired without use and as a result to throw it away.
All remaining items that we have currently in our stock will be good enough for this year. "

Text Removed - Human Resources had a meeting with the officer and instructed him to ask for the approval for this kind of actions to avoid the same situation at a later stage.

Text Removed - Human Resources decided to initiate a SI on this topic. It is described in the attached documents.

Text Removed - Reporting Tools has been informed immediately about this behavior. Text Removed - Human Resources informed the contractor about the incident based on the SIR and notified the contractor by Text Removed - Reporting Tools about the serious incident. He requested the contractor to review the company's monitoring mechanism over the deployed personnel and to replace the concerned interpreter/cultural expert in line with Text Removed - Reporting Tools provisions Text Removed - Reporting Tools. The Text Removed - Human Resources also sent out to the contractor an official letter signed by the Text Removed - Human Resources attaching also the unpaid taxi receipt. Text Removed - Human Resources appointed as Text Removed - Human Resources, after further assessment of the case together with the respective

Measures/actions taken

The interpreter had been recruited by Text Removed - Reporting Tools On the same day, the contractor issued the first deployment notification confirming the employment of the interpreter/cultural expert in question as of 29/03/2021. On 30/03/2021 Text Removed - Human Resources was informed by the Text Removed - Human Resources that the interpreter had not arrived at the deployment location - Fuerteventura - and the contractor was informed that the interpreter was missing. On 31/03/2021, the second deployment notification was issued by the contractor confirming the deployment of the interpreter/cultural expert in question as of 01/04/2021.

Assessment

Text Removed - Reporting Tools on 01/04/2021 the interpreter was due to land in Text Removed - Operational Area. The Text Removed - Human Resources received a call at Text Removed - Reporting Tools from Text Removed - Reporting Tools and he was informed about the undue behaviour of the interpreter. According to the police officer, the interpreter was not even able to speak, not able to fly, he was clearly in a state of drunkenness and was shouting that he was a Frontex employee. He had not paid the fare to the taxi driver, who had nevertheless issued a receipt. The police officer then reported that the interpreter could not have travelled in that condition.

In the end the Text Removed - Human Resources managed to mediate with the taxi driver to try to find a solution.

The interpreters did not take up the assignment and he stayed in Text Removed - Operational Area.
